PARADE & FESTIVAL

- Organized and executed the fourth Annapolis Pride Parade and Festival with famed designer Christian Siriano serving as grand marshal and Governor Wes Moore attending
- Expanded participation with new festival location allowing nearly 200 organizations to participate and raising \$120,000
- Estimated over 11,000 people attended event up nearly 40% over 2023
- Hosted lead up/post parade events including Pride on the Pier with Bread and Butter Kitchen, Pride beer release with Forward Brewing, theme and logo reveal and pre and post pride parties and ecumenical worship service.
- Offered special festival space for parents and kids and an Absolute 21+ area.
- Voted Best Pride Outside of DC for third time by the Washington Blade
- Started float contest where winners included: Xuxa's Carnival for Community Organizations, The Key School for School/Government entity, and PNC for our business/for profit category
- · Increased accessibility to events for disabled community
- Hosted a sponsor thank you event with Annapolis Maritime Museum
